Lectionary

Cantley Church Council has decided that for all services other than 'specials,' preachers are asked to select from the Methodist Church lectionary readings designated for that Sunday.

The church Bibles are the New International Version (UK updated 'inclusive' version). We have a rota of readers to read the lessons. Please let us know if you do not require them.

Prayers

Prayers are usually led by the preacher or minister. However, if you require someone to lead any of the prayers, please let me know so that arrangements can be made.

The traditional version of the Lord's Prayer should be used for all services as we work towards becoming a Dementia Friendly Church

Our book of prayer requests will be present during our services. It is appreciated if the prayer requests can be used during the intercessions.

Offering

Our offering plate is located at the rear of the church. We ask that a prayer of thanks is given for any offerings placed on the plate, and for monies given through electronic means.

Music

Our standard hymn book is Singing the Faith. Our hymns and readings are projected on screen but if anyone requires a printed book, we do have them available. Please remember to announce hymn numbers for those using books or listening to the recording.

Technology

The church has an induction loop system to assist the hearing impaired and with loudspeakers. Preachers will be equipped with a lapel microphone, and a roving microphone is also available if required.

The services are recorded onto CDs for distribution to members of the congregation who are no longer able to attend. The recording is also uploaded to our website therefore we ask that full names are not used during the service.

Worshippers

We are open to all at Cantley and any special needs are accommodated by the congregation. The congregation is a mixture of ages with some children and young people present, ages ranging from about 4 years up to about 10 or 11 years old. The children do not leave during the service and are usually situated at the back of the church where suitable activities are available.

Before the service

Just before each service starts one of the duty stewards will offer a prayer with you in the vestry. A steward will introduce you before the service commences, along with any additional notices, invite the congregation to prepare themselves for worship, and light a candle.

After the service

At the end of the service please exit through the doors at the front of the Church. You may wish to wait in the corridor to meet and greet the congregation who may be leaving the Church.

We also offer refreshments after the service and invite you to join us for tea/coffee and biscuits in the Wesley Room (located next to the rear entrance to the Church).
